Need MAT or Health Services?

This Mobile Clinic visits towns across Greene County to help people who are struggling with active addiction or in need of recovery supports. You will have access to clinicians, peer advocates and a person to prescribe medications for addiction recovery.

The Greener Pathways Mobile Clinic is a partnership with Greene County Public Health, the Healthcare Consortium, and Project Safe Point. We offer many services including these:

- FREE health screenings including: Hepatitis C, HIV, and STI screenings
- Medications for addiction recovery
- Help getting health insurance
- FREE opioid overdose reversal training and kits
- FREE emergency contraception and condoms
- Linkage to clean syringes and harm reduction supplies
- Food, care bags (water, granola bar, Chapstick, and blanket)
